

My License Expires In 2025 ... So What CE Courses Do I Need To Renew?

Continuing Education - the requirements break down as follows:

1. Associates and Broker's License (not BIC)

- 4 hours core ("Legal Hot Tips" is the only approved core course)
- 6 hours elective (any approved course or combination to total a minimum of 6 hours)

2. BIC License

- 4 hours core ("Legal Hot Tips" is the only approved core course)
- 4 hours mandatory BIC course ("What's a BIC to Do?"/"BIC Duties")
- 2 hours of any approved elective

***Once the 10 hours of required CE credit has been completed,
licenses must be renewed through LLR.***

See important dates below.

April 1 - June 30: SC Real Estate Licensees with a June 30 expiration date may renew their licenses from April 1 - June 30.

Licenses not renewed before June 30th of their renewal year will have their license lapse. Lapsed licenses cannot practice and have 24 months to Reinstate for active licensure before license is cancelled. After 24 months, any unrenewed license will be considered cancelled and an individual will have to reapply and requalify.
